# **Uni food waste** fertiliser move

JAMES Cook University has become the first university in the transforms food scraps into fer-

JCU joins Hermit Park State School in using one of the machines.

The machine, which was defood waste to a fertiliser, and is water and a plunger. capable of producing up to 250kg 
It is then ground up twice, pus.

Every year, JCU's kitchens, including its private colleges, produce close to 100 tonnes of food waste. This results in 380 tonnes of carbon dioxide equivalent emissions when sent to the landworld to install a machine that fill – as much as 84 cars on the road for a year.

A \$6500 Bio-Regen unit has unit was developed by Townsbeen installed in the kitchen at ville based company Vital Resource Management, founded by Ken Bellamy.

of re-usable waste product each before being pumped out into large containers, stored outside, where bacteria naturally breaks the food down further over 28 days into a product similar to apple cider vinegar.

The liquid is then further processed into a bio-fertiliser.

#### Gallipoli preservation

WORKS to protect the Gallipoli coastline from further erosion are set to be completed in time for Anzac Day commemorations.

Crucial preservation work has been undertaken by the Turkish government to ensure Anzac Cove is protected from coastal erosion.

A sea wall has been constructed along the back of the beach, linking existing walls on neighbouring Brighton and North beaches. The Anafartlar Road above Anzac Cove also has been upgraded.

The final stage of the work, landscaping and revegetating the area, is under way and will be ready for Anzac Day commemorations on April 25.
